- 1. Son of Zebedee (Matt. 10:2)
  - -John's brother (Acts 12:2)
  - -Martyred by Herod A.D. 44
- 2. Son of Alphaeus (Matt. 10:3)

## Which James?

- 3. Son of Joseph & Mary (Matt. 13:55)
  - -Half-brother of Jesus (Gal. 1:19)
  - -Brother of Jude (Jude 1)

### What do we know?

- Many siblings (5 boys, 2+ girls)
- Second-born? (listed first: Matt. 13:55-6; Mark 6:3)
- Saw miracles (John 2:11-12; 7:1-4)

## What do we know?

- Did not believe... (John 7:5)
- ...Until after Jesus' resurrection (1 Cor. 15:7)
- Witnessed to his brothers? (15:14)

## What did he do?

- Elder in the Jerusalem church
  - -Acts 12:17; 15:13-21; 21:17-18
- Prominent role (Gal. 2:6, 9, 12)
- Tradition: martyred A.D. 62

## To whom was he writing?

- The Twelve Tribes?
  - -Jews in general?
  - -Jewish Christians?
  - -The Church?



## To whom was he writing?

- -Jewish Christians
  - Written early (~ A.D. 45)
  - First believers where Jews (see Acts 2; 11:19-21)

## What about us?

- It is relevant to today
  - -We deal with the same issues
  - -Trials (suffering/persecution)
